

Terms & Conditions

These terms and conditions are applicable to all contracts for the provision of services. Booking confirmations made verbally or via written form i.e. email or letter are subject to these terms and conditions. Please read the following terms and conditions of sale carefully before booking with us. By purchasing service from us, you agree to these terms and conditions.

Cancellations - Deposits

Should you wish to cancel your booking 90 days notice is required for a full refund of your deposit or booking fee. Any cancellation under 90 days of your event will result in the deposit or booking fee being lost - (non refundable). If a licence for your event has already been applied for, the cost of this will be deducted from your deposit or booking fee/if when returned.

A minimum deposit of £50 to be paid on booking. The booking/hire charge is £250.00. The balance due 90 days prior to the event taking place. You can of course pay in full when booking. If you require us to travel more than 50 miles, there will be an additional fee. This will be discussed and agreed upon prior to the booking being finalised and signed by the client.

If full payment is not received before the 90 days prior to the event, we will be unable to provide our services and any deposits pre-paid will be non-refundable.

Rum-n-Gin Bar accepts no liability for any failure to provide our services which is a circumstance beyond our control, for example, extreme weather conditions, vehicle road traffic collision/breakdown, electricity failure, or an "act of god"

All verbal and emailed quotations will be valid for seven days from date of enquiry. The Rum-n-Gin Bar can not guarantee that your date will be available after these seven days. To confirm a booking, the client must provide a booking deposit either by credit or debit card or electronic transfer within seven days of receiving an invoice/quote

Setting up - Siting of Bar - Damages

All clients are responsible for their guests actions, where a guest damages any of the Rum-n-Gin Bar or the vehicle that pulls the bar, you the client will be held responsible for

repairing and or replacing the item as the manufacturer sees fit.

The client is responsible for the behaviour and conduct of its guests. Should any staff find themselves being abused throughout the event, Rum-n-Gin Bar will cease to operate, and the police will be called/informed.

Throughout the event, our vehicle needs to be parked reasonably close to the bar/trailer, so as to allow us to restock the bar as the event goes on and to give us somewhere to dispose of our rubbish and dirty glasses.

Rum-n-Gin bar will dispose of all waste created by them, we will not be held responsible for removing other waste not created by them from the event

Any loss or breakages of hired equipment will be the responsibility of the client and must be paid in full within 14 days of the event. Glassware is also included in the hire of equipment and is subject to the same conditions. However, Rum-n-Gin Bar recognizes that glasses are subject to accidental breakages and is willing to waive any loss or breakage if not exceeding 5% of the total number of glasses provided at the event.

We will not, under any circumstances, park or unload in any areas where our vehicle may be towed away, locked in, clamped or be given an endorsable penalty. If any parking fines are incurred for any reason on the day of the event - You the client will be held responsible for the paying of said fine

We require approximately 1.5 hours to set up. Where access is difficult, it may take longer to set up and break down, however the more time we are allowed the better. We require a minimum of 1.5 hours from the bar closing to make the bar safe to travel and vacate the venue, if access is good. The preparation of making the bar ready to vacate the event can only take place when the area is clear to allow the vehicle and trailer to do so. We will not incur any cost due to delay caused by the area nor being clear of guests or any other time delaying factors.

Our trailer requires a 32 AMP electrical connection. If this is not available at your event we can bring a suitable 5.5KVA generator to the event. As all generators are quite noisy, we try to locate it as far away as possible. We do have a 30 metre cable, however please consider this when locating us at your event.

The Law

Your venue, regardless of where it is held, will require a licence. If the venue has no licence, we can if required, apply for one on your behalf. Once the venue is licenced, the same rules apply, that apply to any pub or club, as with all licenced premises the Rum-n-Gin bar operates under The Licensing Act 2003 and we operate a "think 21" policy;

No Alcohol To Be Sold To Anyone Under The Age Of 18.

All guests that appear to be under the age of 18 will be asked for a photo ID.

Please ensure guests that may be required, are informed to bring photo I.D if they wish to be served and save any embarrassment on the day.

Please do not attempt to buy alcohol for under 18's - It is an offence to buy alcohol for a person under the age of 18. It is an offence for us to supply alcohol to an adult if we believe it will be supplied to a person under the age of 18.

The Rum-n-Gin Bar is not responsible for acquiring temporary event notices for paid bar events unless required to in writing and therefore is also not responsible for any breaches of licences outside of The Rum-n-Gin Bars control.

Tap Water

As we are a mobile bar we are unable to provide tap water for your guests - please make sure this is readily available should your guests require it. As per "The 2014 Order" which forms part of the Licensing Act 2003 states "free tap water should be readily available to guests/customers where it is reasonably available. Being a mobile bar, we are not plumbed into a mains supply, so it is not reasonably available.
